Myles Turner

Lower 7.5 Rebounds

Due to his recent form, Myles Turner will grab fewer than 7.5 rebounds against the Raptors. His form hasn't been consistent and even without Jakob Poeltl in the lineup, the Raptors still emphasize team rebounding, which can limit Turner's opportunities. Turner's tendency to focus on shot-blocking and rim protection over crashing the boards further reduced his chances of reaching that rebound mark.



DeMar DeRozan

Higher 34.5 Points+Rebounds+Assists

DeMar DeRozan will surpass the 34.5 mark against the Knicks due to favorable matchups and his recent strong form. The Knicks' perimeter defense, particularly with players like Josh Hart, can struggle against elite mid-range scorers like DeRozan, allowing him to capitalize in his comfort zones. DeRozan's recent performances have shown a well-rounded contribution in scoring, playmaking, and rebounding, making it likely he will exceed the combined total against New York's defense.



Domantas Sabonis

Lower 28.5 Points + Assists


Sabonis will fall short of 28.5 points and assists against OKC due to their solid defensive schemes and the presence of defensive anchor Chet Holmgren, who can disrupt Sabonis in the paint. OKC's ability to switch effectively on defense limits Sabonis' opportunities to exploit mismatches and could reduce his scoring and playmaking. Additionally, Sabonis' recent form may have leaned more toward facilitating rather than aggressive scoring, making it difficult for him to hit the combined mark.



GG Jackson

Lower 18.5 Points

GG Jackson will score fewer than 18.5 points against the Spurs due to his limited offensive role and inconsistent output in recent games. The Spurs' defense, led by Wembanyama, can effectively challenge shots in the paint and disrupt offensive flow, making it hard for Jackson to find buckets. Additionally, as a young player still developing in the league, Jackson will struggle to consistently reach that point total against a disciplined defensive team like the Spurs.



Jabari Smith Jr

Higher 13.5 Points

Smith Jr will score more than 13.5 points against the Orlando Magic given his recent scoring surge and growing role in the Rockets' offense. Orlando's defense, while solid, has gaps on the perimeter that Smith could exploit with his shooting range and ability to stretch the floor. Additionally, his matchup against Orlando's forwards, who can be inconsistent defensively, provided him with a favorable opportunity to exceed the points projection.
